


PenderROCK 2010

Welcome West Family Reunion!



Abt 1760 - 7/23/1834

Revolutionary War Soldier
PenderROCK Ancestor

Your ancestor was a Revolutionary War veteran. He was a private. Matthew Jacobs, and Josiah Jacobs served as well. Primus drew his pension commencing November 1, 1819.

It's such a blast that the descendants of Uncle Arthur & Uncle Levy's siblings 'sneak in' (lovingly welcomed). Sam, Hezekiah, Lee, and Tyrone from Annie Walker. Bernice & Vivian from Joel Walker. Evelina and Annie from Johnnie Walker. Probably more, too.

Hattie Jacobs. Hattie is a descendant of Anguish Jacobs; her husband Ivey James Jacobs was a descendant of Major Jacobs. Her large family cooks out each July 4th also. We stopped in – a little early. Happy to see the many folks already there. Certain that more came later.

'On Cypress' Planned to get up on Cypress to visit with the descendants of Annie Jacobs, Tink Merritt, Major Jacobs. They, too, cook *real NC barbeque* each 4th!!! This land was inherited by Rev. War Primus Jacobs from his Uncle Matthew. It was passed to his son Matthew, and then (after a 1917 court battle between 1/2 siblings) inherited by Matthew's son Taylor Jacobs and his siblings. Has been in Jacobs possession since the late 1700s. SO KEEP IT!!
