

It's So Hard to Say Goodbye to Yesterday

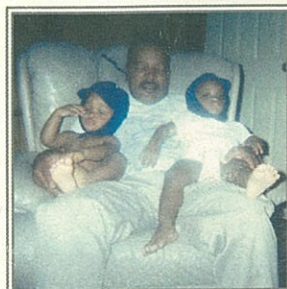
